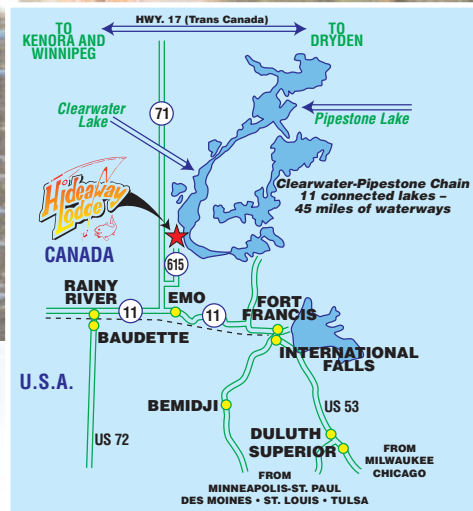

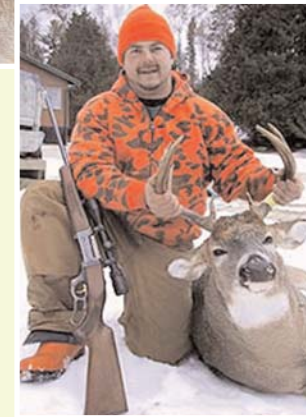

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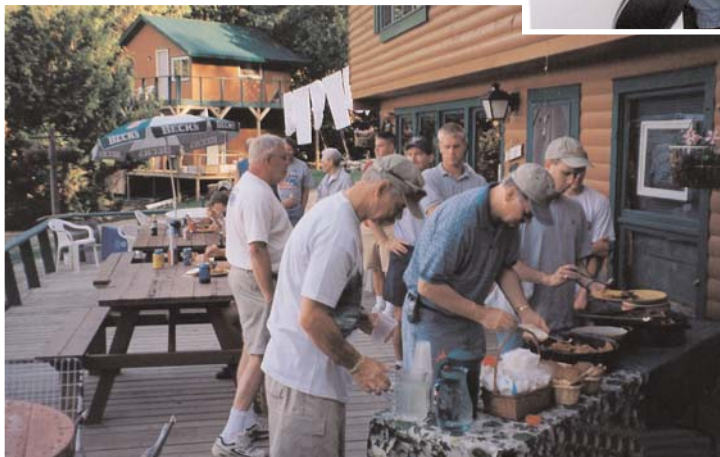
Whether you come to fish, to swim, or to just relax in the pristine Canadian outdoors – Hideaway Lodge has everything you could want. Located on a secluded bay on beautiful

Clearwater Lake, the Main Camp is only one hour northwest of the International Falls/Fort Francis port of entry.



The Camp

Hideaway Lodge offers American Plan home-cooked meals. Our Main Lodge has a rustic dining room and a comfortable common area with satellite TV. It's perfect for accommodating corporate groups, families, anglers and hunters.



Clearwater Lake itself offers excellent fishing for Smallmouth Bass, Walleyes, and Muskies. But it's the entire chain of 11 lakes (about 70 miles of water) that offers an unsurpassed Canadian wilderness fishery. All eleven lakes – linked together by 2 mechanical portages – are accessible by boat, and together offer some of the best Walleye, Northern Pike, Muskie, Smallmouth Bass, Largemouth Bass, Lake Trout and Yellow Perch fishing in Ontario. To help you get to all those fish... we have 17-1/2 foot Lunds with 50-hp Yamaha motors.



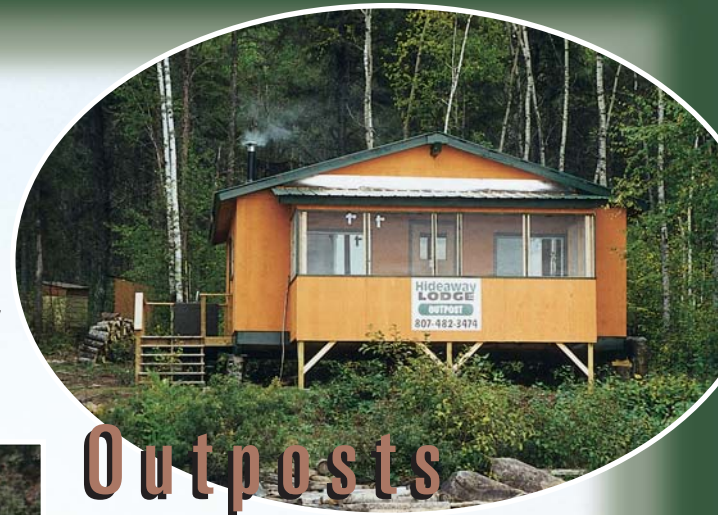
If you want more than fishing, we have that too. For a change of pace, spend a day on one of the two golf courses within 40 miles of camp. Other local opportunities include grouse and deer hunting, a trip to Ancient Native Burial Mounds, paper mill tours and shopping in Fort Francis, float plane sight-seeing trips, fly-in fishing trips to other remote lakes, berry picking, and the simple enjoyment of the pristine scenery. A grocery/souvenir/liquor store is located only five minutes from camp.



Our Main Camp includes five modern cabins, each with a beautiful view of Clearwater Lake. All cabins feature well-equipped kitchens, showers, electricity, comfortable beds, with clean line-dried linens, and daily maid service. The camp has a safe sandy swimming beach, hiking trails, paddleboats, canoes, a swimming dock, horseshoe pits, and fish-cleaning and freezing facilities. Every Tuesday night we have a fish fry for the entire camp.

Outposts

Our outpost cabins, accessible only by boat or float plane, offer even more seclusion – and, of course, excellent fishing.

Jackfish Outpost: This brand-new cabin on West Jackfish Lake (25 miles from main camp by boat) sleeps up to 10 people, is solar-powered, and has wood heat. Walleye, Northern Pike, Bass and Perch dominate the Jackfish end of the chain.

Pipestone Outpost: This cabin on the Northwest Arm of Pipestone Lake (28 miles from main camp by boat) sleeps up to 8 people, is solar-powered, and has wood heat. Pipestone Lake is famous for its Walleyes, Northern Pike, Muskies, Lake Trout and Smallmouth Bass.
